BHANGRA REFERS TO SEVERAL FORMS OF FOLK DANCE AND MUSIC THAT ORIGINATE IN THE PUNJAB REGION OF INDIA. THE DANCE IS GENERALLY PERFORMED DURING THE VAISAKHI FESTIVAL THAT CELEBRATES THE HARVEST. BHANGRA HAS A VERY ENERGETIC AND LIVELY TONE AND THE DANCE IS EQUALLY VIVACIOUS.

ABOUT GIDDHA


GIDDHA IS A POPULAR FOLK DANCE OF WOMEN IN PUNJAB REGION OF INDIA AND PAKISTAN. THE DANCE IS OFTEN CONSIDERED DERIVED FROM THE ANCIENT DANCE KNOWN AS THE RING DANCE AND IS JUST AS ENERGETIC AS BHANGRA; AT THE SAME TIME IT MANAGES TO CREATIVELY DISPLAY FEMINE GRACE, ELEGANCE AND FLEXIBILITY. PUNJAB

Punjab is an Indian state situated in the North-west part of India. It is the 12th largest state by area and 16th largest state by population. It has Jammu Kashmir to the North, Himachal Pradesh to the East, Rajasthan to the South-west and Shares International Border with Pakistan to the West. It is comprised of 22 district and Punjabi is the most spoken language in the state.

HISTORY OF PUNJAB

Punjab was created in 1947, when the partition of India split the former Raj province of Punjab between India and Pakistan. The mostly muslim western part of the province became Pakistan's Punjab province, the mostly Sikh eastern part became India's Punjab state. Himachal Pradesh and Haryana were also carved out of the Punjab state.

GEOGRAPHY

Punjab is a sub-tropical region and receives average rainfalls. It is very hot in summer and cold in winter. It has various ranges of flora and fauna. Punjab State is known for its fertile land and many rivers.

Punjab is divided into three distinct regions on the basis of soil types: southwestern, central and eastern. The extraction of silk from silkworms is another industry that flourishes in the land state.

ECONOMY

Punjab is majorly an agriculture based state. It is the highest wheat producing state of India. It produces 10.26% of India's cotton, 19.5% of India's wheat and 11% of India's rice. It also produces vegetables, sugarcane, fruits and other crops. The textile industry is one of the biggest in Punjab along with the manufacturing and Agro industries. The tourism industry is also one of the biggest in

ready, and has much less adhesive strength - which make it difficult to handle. Makhi di roti is generally made during winter in Punjab.

DANCE

Bhangra started in Punjab region, now divided between India and Pakistan and began as a folk dance which was conducted by Punjab farmers of all creeds, Sikhs, Muslims and Hindus to celebrate the coming of the harvest season.

FESTIVALS

Punjabis celebrate a number of festivals, which have taken a semi-religious meaning and are regarded as cultural festivals by people of all religions. Some of the festivals are Baisakhi, Vaisakhi, Lehr, Gursikhs Ganga Shabdants, Joghri and Baisakhi rice festival.

In rural Punjab, the salwar is still called suthan.

CROPS



The largest crop grown in Punjab is wheat. Other important crops are rice, cotton, sugarcane, millets, maize, barley and fruits. The principal crops are wheat, rice, maize and sugarcane.



Among the fodder crops are Bajra and Juar.

DISHERS

Sarso da sag is a popular vegetarian dish from one Punjab and Rajasthan region of the Indian subcontinent made from mustard greens (sarso) and Indian spices. Makhi di Roti is a Punjabi bread made from corn meal, primarily eaten in

Punjabi Bhangra and folk songs are very famous through the country. Punjabi cuisine of Sarso da Sag is also very famous. Punjab is known for the sports enthusiasm and many people from the state reached the highest level of the respective sports.

GOLDEN TEMPLE (Religious place)

The Golden temple is the holiest shrine of Sikhs. It was built in late 16th century by Guru Arjan, and a copy of scriptures was placed inside temple in 1604. Its sanctum walls was covered in and the dome was decorated with gold foil by Ranjit Singh in the 19th century. More than 100,000 people visit golden temple every year.

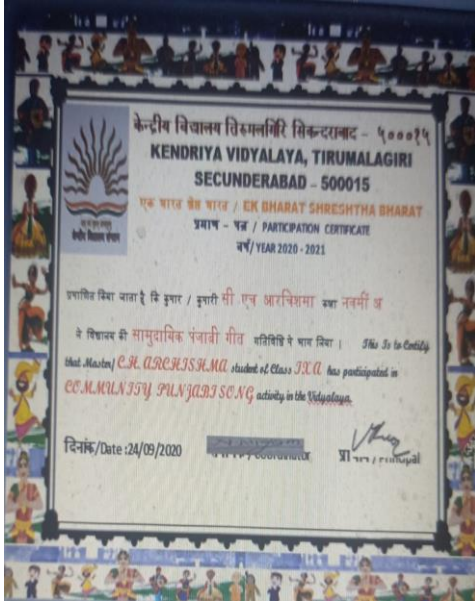
Events & Programs of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat -
